



MTPA Perspective Regarding Medicare Coverage

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As an FDA-approved therapy, RADICAVA™ (edaravone) will have coverage under Medicare policy. However, each local administrator may choose to establish independent criteria for coverage. Claims are processed through nine local Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) responsible for 12 geographical jurisdictions.

For specifics regarding Medicare coding and coverage, Health Care Providers (HCPs) should contact their local MAC carrier.
